Flood situation -2019

(up to – 31st July , 2019)

Highlights- Bihar floods: 130 dead, 85.16 lakh hit as situation turns grim...

Total Flood affected districts- 13 i.e. Sitamarhi, Sheohar, East Champaran, West Champaran, Muzaffarpur, Madhubani, Darbhanga, Supaul, Araria, Saharsa, Katihar, Purnia, and Kishanganj.

Total affected Village/Panchayat- 12053

Action taken by the IRCS, District branches:-

The concerned flood affected districts branches have started distribution of tarpaulin sheets, and dry food items i.e. beaten rice and jaggery as per their capacity from the beginning the of the flood to the flood victims.

- Madhubani - 500 tarpaulin sheets and 300 dry food items like beaten rice and jaggery
- Sitamarhi - 300 tarpaulin sheets and 400 dry food items like beaten rice and jaggery
- Kishanganj - 400 dry food items like beaten rice and jaggery.
- Ararea - Organized community kitchen
- Darbgabga - Organized three health check-up camps for 500 flood victims.

Around 40 Youth Red Cross volunteers of Sitamarhi district branches are preparing bundles of dry food items. →



In Araria District Branch around 30 Red Cross Volunteers are involved in preparing and distributing gallimaufry (Khichari) among the flood victims.





Health Camp was organized by IRCS, Darbhanga district branch at Kakodha - panchayat in Taradih Blocj in which 500 people were benefitted.

Total 40 volunteers were involved.
